



**GREAT SOUTH BAY YACHT RACING ASSOCIATION (GSBYRA)
TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR USE OF GSBYRA OWNED FLYING SCOT SAILS
IN GSBYRA CHAMPIONSHIP LADDER EVENTS**

In order to better equalize the sailing characteristics of both GSBYRA and non-GSBYRA owned Flying Scots in Championship Events, the GSBYRA owns and provides 12 sets of identical same vintage sails. **These suits of sails are not to be rotated among the boats during an event.**

A full suit consists of a mainsail numbered GSBYRA 1 - GSBYRA 12, 4 mainsail battens (2 long, 2 short), rolled mainsail bag, jib with sewn in battens, 2:1 purchase jib sheets with pigtail, rolled jib bag, spinnaker numbered 1 – 12, and spinnaker bag.

Non GSBYRA owned boats shall provide their own spinnaker sheets and all other spinnaker gear.

1. Upon a crew's arrival at the regatta venue, it shall report to the GSBYRA Championship Boat and Sails Chair to be assigned a suit of sails.
2. Crews are not to apply tape or telltales to sails or to make holes in sails.
3. Any lost or missing equipment is to be reported to GSBYRA immediately upon its discovery.
4. Any decisions regarding sails during the course of the event will be left to the race committee or jury of the host club.
5. At the event's conclusion, sails and equipment are to be dried, rolled, inserted in the sail bags, and returned to the GSBYRA Championship Boat and Sails Chair.
