1 Rules

The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

2 Eligibility and Entry

Sunfish Class members shall be eligible by completing the following registration form and paying the entry fee prior to the end of check in. Sunfish may register and join the Class at check in to satisfy eligibility. Membership reconciliation will be directed to the Class office.

The NY Sunfish Regional is a World Qualifier for the 2008 Sunfish Worlds, at the Buffalo Canoe Club, (Ontario CA) August 25-30th 2008. US Sunfish must be members of the USSCA to be eligible to sail and to qualify for the Worlds. Non US Sunfish may sail if members of ISCA. Worlds Qualification is further described in the ISCA/USSCA Class notice at www.SunfishClass.org.

3 Fees

Required Fees: Checks should be made payable to: "Sayville Yacht Club"
The Entry Fee is \$45. (\$40 for USSA members). The Entry will include dinner on Saturday night and refreshments after racing bottled water and snacks while racing.

4 Registration

Registration will be held from 0800 – 0945 July 7th. Competitors may register in advance by emailing the form following or as found on the SayvilleYC.org website, to PJPatin@nyc.rr.com.

5 Schedule of Events

5.1 Saturday, July 14

0800 hrs - 0945 hrs; Check-in and registration

1000 hrs; Skippers meeting

1100 hrs; First Warning, racing back to back.

1800 hrs; Regatta Dinner (or as soon after sailing as practicable)

5.2 **Sunday, July 15**

1000 hrs; First warning signal, races to follow

No warning signal will be made after 1500 hrs on Sunday. Awards to follow ASAP after last race.

6 Sailing Instructions

7 Courses & Racing Area

- 7.1 Courses will be windward leeward, triangle or a variation to accommodate the fleets and to maximize the number of races. The finish may be different from the start and possibly to starboard of the RC boat.
- 7.2 The racing area will be in the Great South Bay waters south of Blue Point.

8 Scoring

- 8.1 The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A4, will be used except as modified below.
- 8.2 A minimum of One (1) race must be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 8.3 When six (6) or more races are completed a boat may discard their worst score.

9 Risk

It is the competitor's decision to enter the regatta and to start or continue any race. The competitors are ultimately responsible for the risks. The competitor will accept full responsibility for all his/her actions during any activity related to the event. This includes onshore activities before, during, and after the regatta.
