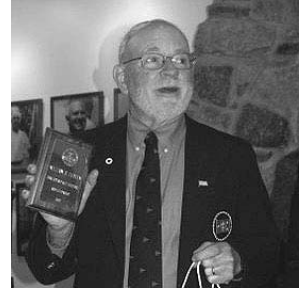


GSBYRA SERVICE AWARD

GSBYRA Meetings

Officers and Committee Chairpersons present reports and organize meeting agendas to address specific issues on which only the 16 GSBYRA Full Member Club Delegates may vote. Sailors should contact any of the Officers or their club Delegate listed on the following pages to request an issue be placed on the agenda at least one week prior to the meeting. Sailors are invited to attend meetings, but cannot vote on issues.
